

## Italian White Wines

### **Falesco Est!Est!!Est!!!, Umbria**

**\$6.00 \$30.00**

In 1100 A.D. when a German bishop traveled to Rome under the instructions of Henry V to find the best wines and eateries, he was instructed to chalk each eatery wall with the word "Est!" whenever the wine was good enough, or "Est!Est!!" when it was particularly good. In Montefiascone, the servant found wine so superb that he wrote Est!Est!!Est!!!

### **Ca'Rugate Soave Classico, Veneto**

**\$5.50 \$27.00**

This wine is full, fruity and aromatic. Perfectly balanced with a hint of apricot.

### **Fazi Battaglia Verdicchio, Italy**

**\$5.50 \$27.00**

A delicate wine with a hint of fruit. Dry, refined and balanced.

### **La Carria Orvieto, Umbria**

**\$6.00 \$30.00**

Delicate with fresh fruit aromas, this medium-bodied Italian wine has nice structure with a dry, crisp finish.

### **Stella Pinot Grigio, Umbria**

**\$5.50 \$27.00**

Vibrant on the palate with fresh fruit and balanced acidity. Light and refreshing.

### **Zenato Pinot Grigio, Veneto**

**\$6.00 \$30.00**

Medium-bodied with peach notes, a rich mouthfeel and a moderate finish.

### **Lungarotti Pinot Grigio, Umbria**

**\$38.00**

The decisive characteristics of this variety, integrated with the Umbrian environment, give this Pinot Grigio a full and well-balanced flavor. Crisp acidity and delicate fruit flavors lead to a finish that is exciting and lively.

### **Regaliali Bianco, Sicily**

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

This is a youthful, refreshing wine with aromas of green apple and banana. It is dry and pleasant, with excellent structure and aromatic persistence.

### **Zenato Lugana, Veneto**

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

Straw colored with a floral bouquet that hints at orange blossom, this wine is dry on the palate with balanced acidity and a slight almond-like finish.

## Sauvignon Blanc/Fume Blanc

### **Geyser Peak Sauvignon Blanc, Sonoma**

**\$6.00 \$30.00**

Ideal for seafood, this wine displays classic gooseberry, grapefruit and grassy characteristics.

### **Sterling Sauvignon Blanc, North Coast**

**\$6.50 \$32.00**

Copious melon and fig aromas, this medium-bodied, fruit-driven wine has great structure, with a light, spicy finish.

### **Ferrari Carano Fume Blanc, California**

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

Slightly toasty with melon and tropical fruit aromas, rich finish of fig, honeysuckle and tangerine flavors.

## Chardonnay

<b>Columbia Crest Chardonnay, Washington</b>	<b>\$5.00 \$25.00</b>
Layers of butterscotch, cinnamon and nutmeg are expressed in the nose. Clean and spicy on the palate, this medium-bodied wine has a lingering finish, making it a wine to savor.	
<b>Beaulieu Vineyards Coastal Chardonnay, North Coast</b>	<b>\$6.00 \$30.00</b>
Herb and apple flavors with a touch of lime blossom show fine vitality matched with a good supple mouthfeel.	
<b>Kendall-Jackson Vintners Chardonnay, California</b>	<b>\$7.00 \$35.00</b>
Tropical fruit, mango, citrus and melon aromas and flavors are complemented by a buttery, toasty oak complexity.	
<b>RH Phillips 'Toasted Head' Chardonnay, California</b>	<b>\$7.50 \$37.00</b>
Creamy vanilla and apricot flavors of tropical fruit and slight spiciness are layered with caramelized oak notes. The Toasted Head name comes from the process of charring the barrel heads to create the toasted oak flavors in this perfectly balanced wine.	
<b>J.J. Vincent Pouilly ~ Fuisse, Macon, Burgundy</b>	<b>\$40.00</b>
This chardonnay is clean and crisp with ample fruit and balanced acidity. Excellent food pairing wine.	
<b>Carpe Diem Chardonnay, Edna Valley, California</b>	<b>\$50.00</b>
A bright bouquet of citrus is followed by flavors of pineapple, honey and apple notes. This steely Chardonnay has a creamy texture which is followed by a long, rich finish.	
<b>Jordan Chardonnay, Russian River Valley</b>	<b>\$60.00</b>
On the palate, this wine is vibrant and rich with flavors that include fresh apricot, pear, citrus and honey balanced with toasty oak. It has a long, expansive finish that ends with just the right amount of acidity.	

## Riesling

<b>Trimbach Riesling, Alsace</b>	<b>\$7.00 \$35.00</b>
Dry and finely-structured, but very fruity. The wine's intense fruit is given great length by a backbone of crisp acidity.	

## White Zinfandel

<b>Nathanson Creek White Zinfandel, California</b>	<b>\$5.00 \$25.00</b>
Pale pink, fresh and fruity with a soft texture and crisp flavors.	

## Champagne

## Cabernet Sauvignon

**Stonehedge Cabernet Sauvignon, California** **\$5.50 \$27.00**

This Cabernet displays ripe juicy layers of plum, blackberry and currant with hints of anise and violets on the finish.

**Snoqualmie Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley** **\$6.50 \$32.00**

Diverse aromas, including black raspberry, rosemary, anise and vanilla tickle the senses. Plenty of dark fruit precede a soft, lush finish.

**Estancia Cabernet Sauvignon, California** **\$7.00 \$35.00**

Smooth, rich and complex with lots of eucalyptus, wildberry, cherry and spice nuances.

**Chateau Ste. Michelle Cabernet Sauvignon, Washington** **\$7.00 \$35.00**

Firm in texture with blackberry, blueberry and currant flavors and toasty, smoky notes on the finish.

**Estancia Meritage, Alexander Valley** **\$52.00**

A sophisticated blend of Cabernet and Merlot which produces a rich, complex and luscious wine. Great aromas of black pepper, toasted oak and caramel notes; finishing with dark fruit flavors and ripe tannins.

**1997 Chalk Hill Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma** **\$90.00**

The wine has aromas of blackberry, black cherry, clove and ripe plum, overlaid with spicy oak and peppered earthiness that is an essence of Chalk Hill appellation. Flavors are complementary and mid-palate sweetness yields gracefully firm, broad tannins in the finish.

## Merlot

**Talus Merlot, California** **\$5.00 \$25.00**

This Merlot is a rich, medium-bodied wine that bursts with flavors of cherry, plum and herbs. Sweet toasty oak lingers on the finish.

**Kris 'Heart' Merlot, Alto Adige** **\$6.50 \$32.00**

Garnet in color with intense perfumes of dried woodland fruits that carry through on the palate. Easy to drink with a lingering finish.

**Chateau Souverain Merlot, Alexander Valley** **\$38.00**

A pretty nose with toasty vanilla aromatics. Blueberry and earthy flavors carry through to a long, soft finish.

**Hanna Merlot, Alexander Valley** **\$52.00**

This full-bodied Merlot boasts black cherry, raspberry and mint aromas intermingled with layers of nutmeg and sweet vanilla. On the palate, the wine is soft and complemented by flavors of rich fruit, oak and velvety tannins.

## Italian Red Wines

### **Pietrafitta Chianti Colli Senesi, Tuscany**

**\$5.50 \$27.00**

The ripe cherry core sports tea and spice accents and closes with fine tannins and a dusty rose note.

### **Castello D'Albola Chianti Classico, Tuscany**

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

Full-bodied with delicate scents of violets, this wine is distinctive because of its fragrant bouquet and the elegant harmony of its flavor.

### **Allegrini Valpolicella, Veneto Region**

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

This wine is characterized by chocolate-like overtones with moderate alcohol levels and balanced acidity. It is lively and easy to drink with moderate tannins and a bright vivacious color. This wine exhibits fragrant and intense fruit.

### **Batasiolo Barbera D'Alba, Piedmont**

**\$35.00**

Very dark ruby with ample fruit aromas. This wine is soft and fruity in the mouth with flavors of wild cherry and berry, ending with a tart, spicy finish.

### **Ruffino Lodola Nuova, Nobile di Montepulciano, Tuscany**

**\$38.00**

An elegant and velvety wine, which is full and flavorful with very intense dried cherry and plum characters. Medium-bodied with fine tannins and a fruity, vanilla and spice finish.

### **Melini 'La Selvanella' Chianti Classico Reserve, Tuscany**

**\$45.00**

Dark ruby, with ripe black raspberries and heady floral aromas. Full and juicy fruit flavors perfectly balanced with lemony acidity.

### **Travaglini Gattinara, Piedmont**

**\$45.00**

Full-bodied with mocha, smoky tea and dried fruit on the nose. Finishing with soft, silky tannins.

### **Fontevocchi, Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany**

**\$60.00**

Ripe, round, spicy and complex. This wine is distinctively elegant and generous with its ripe berry, nutmeg, vanilla and tar aroma and flavors.

### **Santa Sofia Amarone, della Valpolicella, Veneto**

**\$68.00**

Very intense bouquet with a delicate full and velvety taste. Ruby red in color that deepens to garnet in the glass.

## Sangiovese

### **Valley of the Moon Sangiovese, Sonoma**

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

The intricate aromas include smoky and woody notes, as well as spiced fruit tones. Complex finish with ripe cherry tones and oaky, peppery nuances.

### **Turnbull Sangiovese, Napa Valley**

**\$43.00**

Deep and earthy with cherry, plum and raspberry aromas. Hints of nutmeg and cinnamon with a long, smooth finish.

## Zinfandel

### Toad Hollow "Cacophony" Zinfandel, Paso Robles

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

Fragrant with juicy raspberries, it wants to dance, but not alone. So join the party and let it rip. Let it drip. After all, it's a juicy, jammy wine that is elegant, smooth and harmonious, it's lip smackin' delicious and most of all, it's from Toad Hollow, where the party's just begun!

### Valley of the Moon Zinfandel, Sonoma

**\$38.00**

Toasty oak serves as a handsome accent to deep, blackberry fruitiness first in the polished aromas and then again in the rich and relatively complex flavors of this nicely structured young wine.

### Lolonis Zinfandel, Renwood Valley

**\$45.00**

#### "Lady Bugs Love Lolonis"

Intense ripe flavors of black cherries and wildberries with hints of chocolate. Nicely rounded tannins and a pleasing spiced finish. 100% organically grown.

## Pinot Noir

### Villa Mt. Eden Coastal Pinot Noir, California

**\$5.50 \$27.00**

Strawberry and floral aromas lead to a sweet, fruit flavored, medium-bodied wine with a distinct cherry core.

### Beaulieu Vineyards Pinot Noir, Carneros

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

Ripe, black cherry, plum and raspberry aromas, combined with hints of toasty new oak reveal distinct freshness. Medium-bodied flavors, fine tannins and acidity give this wine definition and grace. A velvety texture framed by the soft tannins yields to a long finish.

### Charles Krug Pinot Noir, Carneros

**\$45.00**

Brilliant expression of bright strawberry fruit infused with aromas of violets and spicy oak flavors. The plush palate is supported by wonderfully chewy tannins and a crisp acidic backbone.

### Wild Hog Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley

**\$48.00**

Lots of cherry and dark red fruit with plenty of sweet, toasty oak on the nose. The dark chocolate and vanilla elements weigh in on the palate in this showy wine.

## Shiraz/Syrah

### Yellow Tail Shiraz, South Eastern Australia

**\$5.00 \$25.00**

The Shiraz has a deep red color with bright purple hues and displays impressive spice, licorice and black currant aromas. The palate is perfectly balanced with soft tannins and fine French oak, complemented by ripe fruit flavors.

### RH Phillips 'EXP' Syrah

**\$7.00 \$35.00**

BIG fruit flavors of blackberry, blueberry and boysenberry and aromatic notes of lavender and chocolate. The wine is broad in the mouth, with moderate tannins and a toasty, vanilla oak finish.

### Francis Coppola "Diamond Series" Syrah, California

**\$38.00**

A pretty nose with toasty vanilla aromatics. Blueberry and ripe plum flavors that carry through to a long, soft finish.
